

REGULATION FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF SELF-WORK BY STUDENTS OF THE STOMATOLOGICAL FACULTY

(written work - abstract)

1. Independent work of students (hereinafter - CPC) in the form of written work - essay - is mandatory. A student receives a certain number of points for its implementation, which is added to the sum of the points of the current educational activity.
2. From the list of topics of the abstracts, approved at the session of the department, the student chooses one and performs it independently, observing this regulation.
3. The abstract must be prepared by the student independently.
4. The student must hand over the abstract to the last practical lesson so that the instructor can check it and evaluate it.
5. The defense of the abstract is carried out within the framework of practical classes.
6. Abstract necessarily includes the following sections:
INTRODUCTION (relevance and purpose of this topic);
CONTENTS (the topic itself is revealed through the processing of the literature);
CONCLUSIONS (results of the study done by the student);
LIST (which is issued in accordance with the existing standards of bibliographic description (see: Form 23, approved by the Order of the Higher Attestation Commission of Ukraine on May 29, 2007, No. 342)).
6. Requirements for registration Abstract: the volume - from 5 to 10 pages, text editor - MicrosoftWord, A4 page format, orientation - book, fields - 20 mm; headset - TimesNewRoman, kegl - 14, line spacing - 1.5, style - Normal.
7. Sample design Abstract is contained in appendix number 1 to this Regulation.
8. In case of use of abbreviations, all abbreviations (except for common ones) can only be used after mentioning the full term.
9. If any signs of plagiarism are detected in the abstracts (including, but exhaustion - information downloaded from the Internet, borrowing citations without corresponding references to the author), on the CPC the student receives 5 points without the right to restate.
