

## For Students of Medical Faculties

We have a major commitment to teaching and mentoring medical students in the field of dermatology and venereology. The course Dermatology & Venereology is given to all fourth year students during the academic year. The course consists of a series of lectures and group practical sessions which include a clinical conference where students are able to examine patients.

Upon completion of the course students should be able to:

- 1) Use correct terminology to describe and classify the appearance of skin lesions;
- 2) Recognize the appearance of common dermatoses including skin infections and infestations, eczema, dermatitis, papulo-squamous diseases, bullous disorders, and venereal diseases
- 3) Recognize common skin signs of systemic diseases;
- 4) Know basic principles for treatment and management of common skin diseases.
